OVERALL RULES: Girls who will be a junior for the 2016-2017 school years or reach the age of 16 between September 16, 2015 and September 15, 2016 are eligible. Participation is limited to one year. All contestants must attend Ankeny High School or Ankeny Centennial High School and/or reside within the Ankeny School District. All girls must participate in the following:

- Meeting designed especially for the Miss 16 contestants-Sunday, June 12th at 6:00 pm at the Neveln Center, 406 SW School Street in dining room. If a contestant has a conflict with the clinic time, please contact the Event Chairs, Marla or Michele, to reschedule an alternate clinic time.
- Grand Parade on Saturday, July 9, 9:00am-line up at 8:00 am.
- Attire for the parade is the commemorative shirt with shorts, skirt or pants. There is NO CANDY
 THROWING, if you are caught throwing candy on the parade route, you will not be allowed to participate
 in the contest Saturday night. There will be parade spotters along the parade route. Signage on the cars
 will provided. No additional signs are allowed. Parade spotters will remove Non-Miss Sixteen signage.
- Contest Ceremony on **Saturday, July 9, 7:00pm**, attire for the contest is casual summer dress.
- Contestant must agree to take part in all three divisions of the Miss Sixteen Contest.
- Contestant must have written consent of a parent or guardian to participate.
- Forms must be returned complete with sponsor fee, to the SummerFest Office, Chamber of Commerce Building, 210 South Ankeny Blvd or mailed to Ankeny SummerFest, PO Box 488, Ankeny, IA 50021 no later than May 25, 2016.

SPONSORSHIP: Each contestant is responsible for obtaining a local Ankeny business to sponsor her in the contest. The cost to the business for sponsoring a contestant is \$75. This covers the contestant's portrait, flowers, T-shirt and related expenses of the contest. Have your sponsor make a check payable to ANKENY SUMMERFEST and include payment with your registration form. Please verify with your sponsor, the correct spelling and correct format of their business name for programs and t-shirts, incorrect information cannot be changed after submission for printing. Some sponsor name format changes could occur due to printing size restrictions. Most local businesses are willing to sponsor Miss Sixteen contestants, especially businesses that you and your family patronize-banks, doctors, hair salons, restaurants, etc. Please contact the Ankeny Chamber at 515.964.0685 if assistance is needed.

MISS PHOTOGENIC: Please call Monahan Photographic Artist at (515)963-8119 to schedule your appointment. Contact the studio for questions regarding portraits, sittings, etc. Portraits will be taken by appointment only and appointments will begin in April. You must bring a parent with you to your photo session. Contest portraits will be available at the June 12th clinic. Portraits must be placed in your sponsors' business establishments at least 2 weeks prior to SummerFest, no later than June 22nd and you must pick up your portrait after the weekend of SummerFest. Miss Photogenic winner will receive a \$50 Gift Card. First and Second runner-ups and 4 Honorable Mentions will be recognized.

MISS SCHOLASTIC: Each contestant will complete a brief composition. Topic will be announced for all contestants at the clinic on June 12th. Judging will be based on content originality and creativity. Miss Scholastic will receive a \$50 Gift Card. First and Second runner-ups and 4 Honorable Mentions will be recognized.

MISS COMMUNITY: The award of Miss Community will be given to the individual that has a passion for Ankeny shown through involvement, positive contribution and service to the community. Each Miss Sixteen candidate will be asked to list ways that they have applied their passion. Use your imagination; tell us what you have done to personally contribute to the community. You will be given time at the clinic to list your contributions. Miss Community will receive a \$50 Gift Card. First and Second runner-ups and 4 Honorable Mentions will be recognized.

Miss Photogenic Contest

Appointments: Call the studio at (515)-963-8119 between 9:00-5:30 M-F to schedule your appointment. We have limited dates and times available for the contestants to be photographed. If you call right away to schedule your session, you will have more options to pick from, but if you wait, the available times are going to be limited. The deadline to have your photo taken is June 1.

Photo Session: Your Miss 16 photo session includes one outfit, 10 poses and a single background choice. Appointments will be scheduled every 15 minutes, so please arrive at least 10 minutes before your scheduled time and ready to be photographed. In consideration of others, please be punctual or you may have to wait or possibly reschedule your appointment. You must bring a parent with you.

Viewing Images: Your images will be posted online in a password protected gallery within 2-3 days of your session and you will receive an email with instructions on how to view your images. You will select the image you want to use for the Miss Photogenic Contest and will also have the option to purchase any other photos at that time. Your online gallery will expire1 week from the date the email was sent to you and you must choose your pose for the contest before your gallery expires. If you do not select your pose before your gallery expires, we will choose it for you.

Clothing: We strongly recommend avoiding patterns, stripes, or busy designs which tend to be distracting. Solid, long sleeved shirts photograph best. Short sleeved shirts are also fine, unless you are self-conscious about your arms. Try to avoid sleeveless, cap-sleeve shirts, and tank tops. Neutrals or earth tones (black, white, and tan, gray) always photograph well on subtle backgrounds, and brighter colors photograph well on bright backgrounds.

Hair: Avoid changing your hairstyle or cutting your hair right before your session. Let it be natural. Although Lon tries to help with hair, it is hard to know what your hair is "supposed to look like." So make sure you like the way your hair looks or let Lon know your preferences. Hair style is ultimately your responsibility

Makeup: If you wear makeup, it should be natural, and not heavier than normal. Excess shine can be controlled by using translucent powder that will tone down shine without adding additional color. Concealer should be used to cover up blemishes. Do not wear glitter or shimmery makeup or powder because it can look like beads of sweat in the photographs. Heavy eyeliner is also not recommended because it can make your eyes appear darker. If you wear nail polish, natural or subtle colors look best. Avoid bright colors and make sure you have a fresh coat of polish on so chips don't show in your photos. Try to avoid sunburned or peeling skin before your session.

Glasses: Check with your optometrist to see if they will loan you an empty set of frames similar to yours for your photo session in order to avoid glass glare. Bring your regular glasses also.

Portrait: Your complimentary 11x14 contest print will be delivered to the Miss 16 Committee on or by June 9, 2016.
